Students will learn how to create posterized paintings by using layering and color-blocking techniques.

Students will learn about stretching and preparing their own canvases. They will use stretcher bars and preprimed canvas to build their own canvases from scratch.

4.4 | 1 - 4 pm | ACRYLIC POUR

Students will exercise their creative flow through the experimental, unpredictable painting method of acrylic pours.
