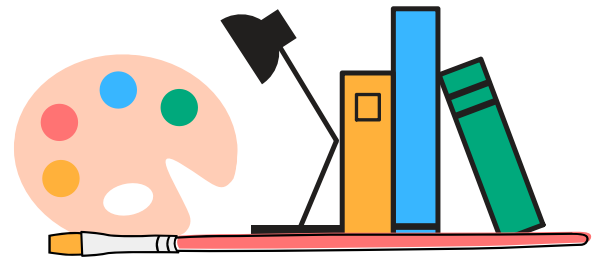
DEC | Leaf Your Mark
