Students will learn how to create visual mind maps as a tool for exploring, analyzing and generating ideas.

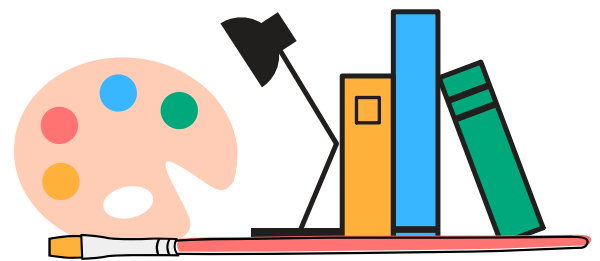
APR | Creative Cartography
