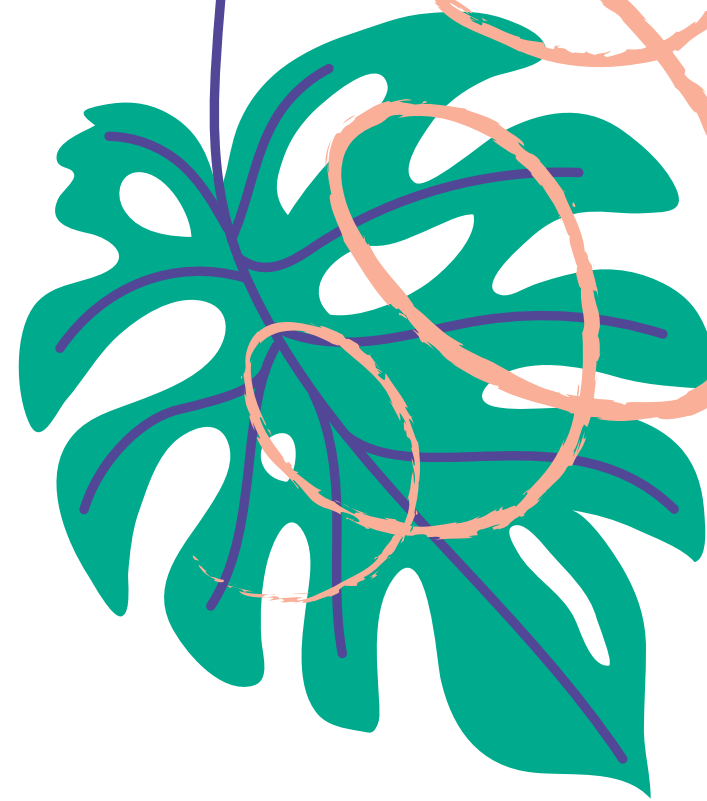

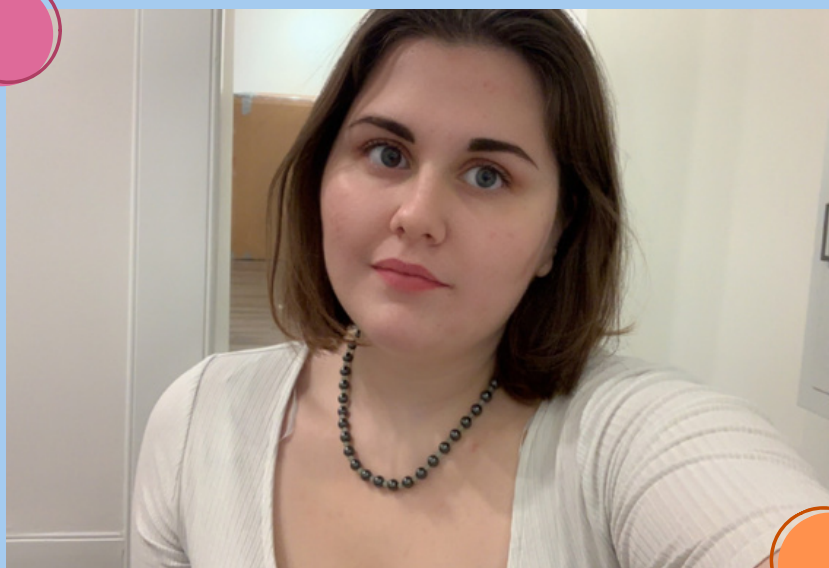

After touring abstract artist Bill Scott's exhibition, students will explore color, movement and form while creating their own nature-inspired layered abstract.

2.12 | 10 - 11:30 am OR 1 - 2:30 pm | Don't Stop Be-leaf-ing

Students will explore the work of exhibiting artist Brian Rutenberg, who is a native of Myrtle Beach! In the studio, students will learn about the expressionism style of painting to create their own abstract expressionist forest.

Students will explore exhibiting artist Alice Ballard's nature-inspired exhibition. Back in the studio, students will learn the art of hand building ceramic pieces while using sea-shells for their inspiration!
