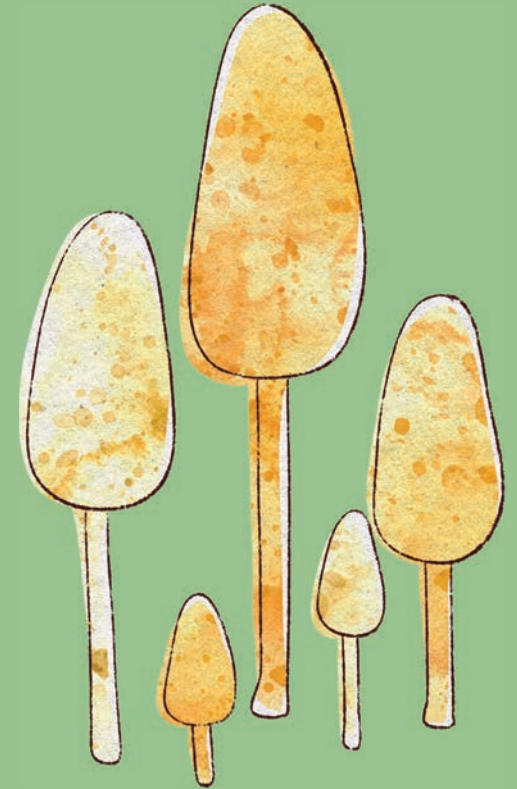

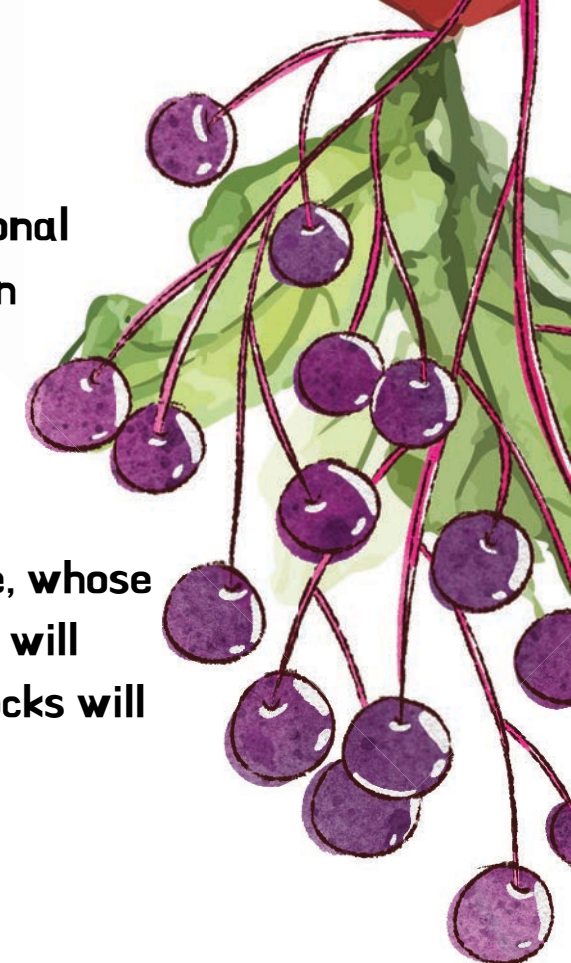

Inspired by The World of Frida exhibition, students will learn about traditional Mexican folk-art. Back in the studio, students will create their own Mexican folk-art inspired mask!
